This Addendum is a modification of the Drawings and Specifications for the referenced project dated 08-23-24 and is hereby incorporated into and becomes part of said Contract Documents. It is to be considered in the proposal and covers additions and/or changes to the Drawings and Specifications.

A. **GENERAL**

- a. A pre-bid meeting was held on Tuesday, September 10, 2024, at Logan Field. Attached is the attendance sheet.
- b. The deadline for the contractors to submit questions was Tuesday, September 17th.
- c. The Architect and Engineers will respond to all questions submitted to the Architect no later than Thursday, September 19th by 2:00 p.m.
- d. Bids are due on Tuesday, September 24, 2024, at 2:00 p.m. Hand deliver a hardcopy of the bid form/s to the attention of Anna Bryant (Township Administrator). Bids submitted before 1:00 p.m. on Tuesday, September 24nd should be dropped off at the Coventry Township offices located at 68 Portage Lakes Drive, Akron, Ohio 44319. All bids that are submitted between 1:00 p.m. and 2:00 p.m. on the 24th, should be dropped off at the Coventry Community Center at 335 E. Willowview Drive, Coventry Township, OH 44319, where the bids will be opened publicly.
- e. This is a tax-exempt project.
- f. The bidders are required to provide a bid bond and a payment/performance bond.
- g. The Township will provide builders risk insurance for this project.
- h. The water-tapping fees will be paid by Coventry Township.
- i. The successful bidder is responsible for obtaining and paying for the building permits. This project has received Conditional Plan Approval from the Summit County Division of Building Standards. The Contractor will be responsible for providing engineered truss drawings in order to receive final plan approval. The application number for this project is CPR240489, and the plan approval notice has been attached to this addendum.
- j. The anticipated notice-to-proceed date is October 7th. The actual start date and construction schedule will be coordinated between the successful bidder and Coventry Township. The Township does not have a specific completion date that has to be met. The date of substantial completion and project closeout will be coordinated with the Contractor and will be incorporated into the construction schedule.

C. CLARIFICATIONS

- 1. **Existing Field House:** The existing field house is to remain operational during construction of the new building. The Contractor will allow access to the existing building and fields while providing temporary fencing to keep the public out of the construction zone.
- Low-Voltage Work: The Owner is responsible for the installation of all low-voltage systems, including but not limited to telecom, data, security cameras, PA systems, etc. The Contractor is responsible for providing and installing any conduit, junction boxes, and power outlets associated with these systems as shown on the Drawings.
- 3. Soil Amendment: There are two acceptable methods to correct the existing soil conditions as outlined in the soils report: Rammed aggregate piers and vibro stone columns. The subcontractor responsible for this work will provide design drawings for review and approval and compaction/bearing capacity test results once the process has been completed. See specification section 31 34 21 Aggregate Pier Soil Reinforcement.
